They shall thoughtfully consider the world and our own ideas and experience. They will work to understand strengths and weaknesses in order to support learning and personal development.



Caring

They shall show empathy, compassion and respect with a commitment to service, and to act to make a positive difference in the lives of others and in the world around us.



Knowledgeable

They shall develop and use understanding, exploring knowledge across a range of disciplines. They will engage with issues and ideas that have local and global significance.



Inquirers

We shall nurture curiosity, developing skills for inquiry and research. They will know how to learn independently and with others, to learn with enthusiasm and sustain a love of learning throughout life.



Resilient

They shall persevere when things get difficult, noticing how things work, the details and patterns. They will learn to manage distractions and try a range of different strategies to find solutions.



Resourceful

They shall ask questions to help them understand more; linking learning from different parts of their life. They will visualise and imagine how things are or how they could be; thinking hard and working things out by using things they know.
